At times pastors in India will request Bibles. We now have a trustworthy contact in India that prints the different dialects of the Bible and is able to make speedy delivery within the country. It works extremely well. Just recently we received a request for Bibles and other materials in the Indian language of Marathi. We were able to go online and order through World Missionary Press. They print pamphlets in many different languages of the world. They mail them to us and we send them out. Postage to India is expensive, but in one box you can mail hundreds of pamphlets. Some of the pamphlets available are: Help from Above, How to Know God, Way to God, The Amazing Life of Jesus Christ.

I, Darryl continue to minister in the prisons here in Texas and I have great support from our local church. The facility I minister in is a psyche ward. I have a great group of men and women who go in with me and are tremendous help.

This last week we were blessed to have Amanda and Giezi Nino who work with Youth With a Mission in Tijuana. They shared about Zona Del Norte. They had felt the Lord calling them to not only go into the Red Light District in Tijuana but to be planted there. They have purchased a small piece of property which does have some shelter. They work with the youth in reading, math, guitar, the Bible and feel that if they educate the youth and give them hope they can change a generation. The moms started coming and they now teach them now to sew and have Bible study. They rent a small building where dads are taught carpentry skills. 1.21 has partnered with them now for years mailing them sewing machines, my used computers, clothing, craft materials that have been donated. Amanda and Giezi also distribute Bibles in the neighborhood. They target a block giving out Bibles, prayer walking and then returning to build relationship within the community. 1.21 has mailed Bibles by the cases in Spanish to help them.

Darryl and I are actively involved in our local church. We have now started a home group that meets once a week and host numerous folks in our home throughout the year. Thanking you so much for praying for us, praying for 1.21 and for supporting 1.21.
